

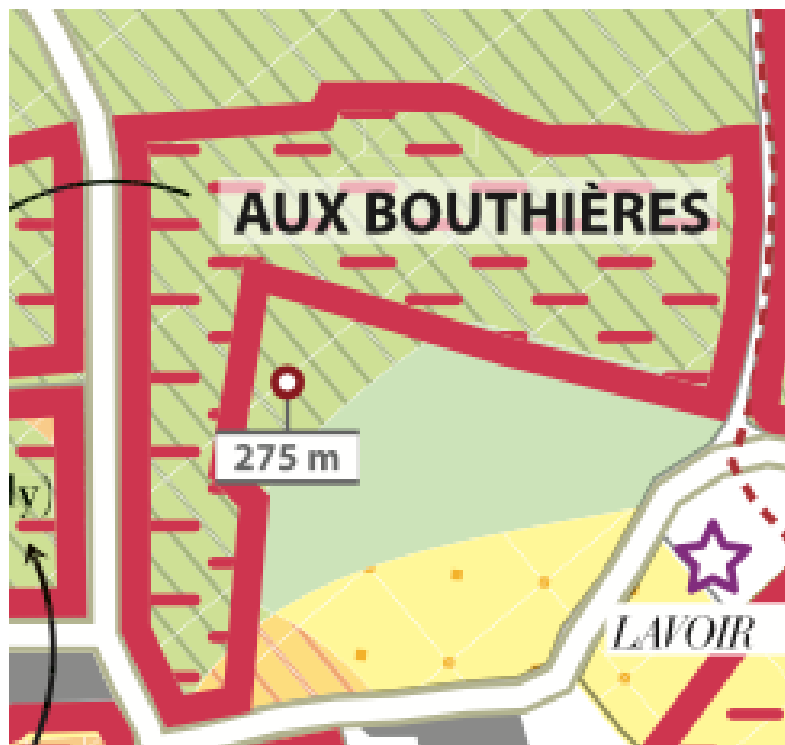

Locality (under 1er Cru): None, partially classified

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: Lands reserved for nurseries
- Botheria, lands suitable for the cultivation of young plants due to the generosity of its soil with few stones.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: In continuity with “Les Chailloux”, it offers a generous terroir with marls derived from residual clays. Although the soil is not calcareous, the terroir still reveals a beautiful mineral finish.

Organoleptic profile: Powerful and refined.



- Area: 4 hectares, 85 ares, and 68 centiares
- Locality: Solutré-Pouilly
- Soil: Brown slope soils with residual clay, chailles, non-calcareous on the surface, slightly rocky.
- Altitude: 260 to 280 meters
- Exposure: South, East, North-East orientation.
