



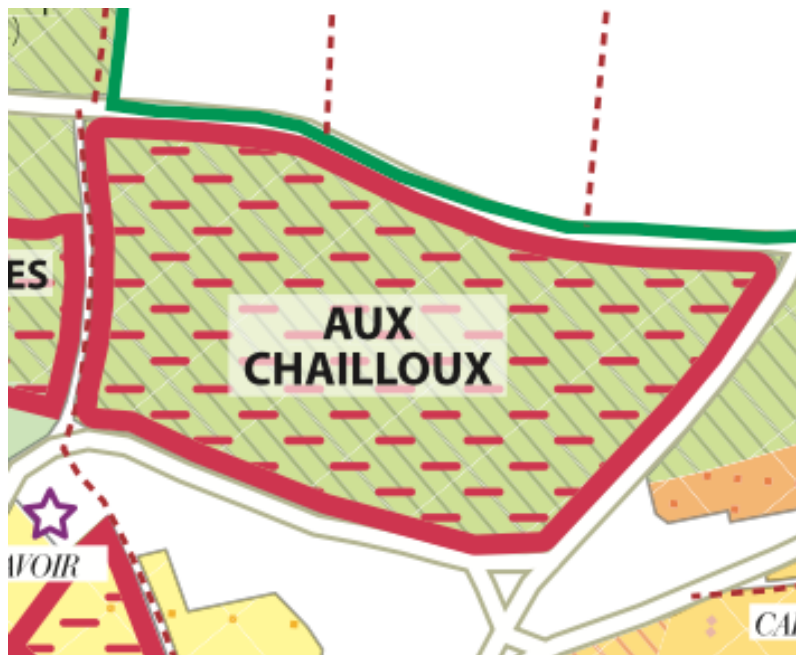
1ER CRU «AUX CHAILLOUX»

Locality (under 1er Cru banner): Climat fully classified.

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: The entire 1er Cru is retained. "Chailloux" comes from "chailles," the name of the flint stones present in this terroir that make it up.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: South-facing exposure that produces early-maturing wines with a fleshy texture.

Organoleptic profile: Silky wines with minerality, lightly smoky or flinty notes.



- Area: 6 hectares and 74 ares
- Locality: Solutré-Pouilly
- Soil: Brown residual clay soils on slopes, with chailles, not calcareous on the surface, slightly rocky.
- Altitude: 245 to 270 meters
- Exposure: South orientation
- Slope: 3 to 10% grade.
