

1ER CRU «EN FRANCE»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Partially classified

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: Would have belonged to Mr. and Mrs. France, a family name. Border area in France in the Duchy of Burgundy. Presence of the Château de France within the 1er Cru, which belonged to Mr. Reverchon.

<u>Special feature of this 1er Cru</u>: The smallest 1er Cru in Vergisson, with sandy clay soils containing iron oxides resting on Sinemurian-type gryphaea limestone (small mollusk fossils). Wines from this terroir have a slow evolution that gives them excellent aging potential.

<u>Organoleptic profile</u>: Dense and rich with lemony aromas, a mineral and saline palate.



- Area: 1 hectare and 87 ares
- Locality: Vergisson
- <u>Soil</u>: Heterogeneous brown slope soils, not very deep, rocky, well-drained, with low surface limestone content, on gryphaea limestone or limestone sandstone bedrock.
- <u>Altitude</u>: 310 to 350 meters
- <u>Exposure</u>: East and South orientation.
