



### 1ER CRU «EN FRANCE»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Partially classified

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: Would have belonged to Mr. and Mrs. France, a family name. Border area in France in the Duchy of Burgundy. Presence of the Château de France within the 1er Cru, which belonged to Mr. Reverchon.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: The smallest 1er Cru in Vergisson, with sandy clay soils containing iron oxides resting on Sinemurian-type gryphaea limestone (small mollusk fossils). Wines from this terroir have a slow evolution that gives them excellent aging potential.

Organoleptic profile: Dense and rich with lemony aromas, a mineral and saline palate.



- Area: 1 hectare and 87 ares
- Locality: Vergisson
- Soil: Heterogeneous brown slope soils, not very deep, rocky, well-drained, with low surface limestone content, on gryphaea limestone or limestone sandstone bedrock.
- Altitude: 310 to 350 meters
- Exposure: East and South orientation.
