

1ER CRU «LA FRÉRIE»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): La Frérie, Les Quarts

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: Likely comes from "Frère" (Brother) or "Confrérie" (Confraternity), pastoral areas near the village of Solutré where "Les Fréries" festivities were practiced.

<u>Special feature of this 1er Cru</u>: Reddish brown soils with few stones and low limestone content but welldrained.

Organoleptic profile: Round, fine floral notes, and generous.



- <u>Area</u>: 4 hectares and 8 ares and 13 centiares
- Locality: Solutré-Pouilly
- <u>Soil</u>: Colorful clayey brown soils, not very rocky and low in limestone content, steep and well-drained.
- <u>Altitude</u>: 280 to 310 meters
- <u>Exposure</u>: South to East orientation.
