

## **1ER CRU «LE CLOS DE SOLUTRÉ»**

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Le Clos, Solutré, Vignes du Riat, La Verchère

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: A synthesis of two of the place-names integrated into this 1er Cru: Le Clos and Solutré.

<u>Special feature of this 1er Cru</u>: At the heart of the village, enclosed by walls, a true Burgundian enclosed vineyard.

Organoleptic profile: Opulent and generous.



- Area: 4 hectares, 39 ares, and 73 centiares
- Locality: Solutré-Pouilly
- <u>Soil</u>: Brown limestone slope soils, very rocky, deep, and healthy.
- Altitude: 290 to 330 meters
- <u>Exposure</u>: South/ Southeast/ East orientation
- <u>Slope</u>: 15% grade.
