



### 1ER CRU «LE CLOS DE SOLUTRÉ»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Le Clos, Solutré, Vignes du Riat, La Verchère

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: A synthesis of two of the place-names integrated into this 1er Cru: Le Clos and Solutré.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: At the heart of the village, enclosed by walls, a true Burgundian enclosed vineyard.

Organoleptic profile: Opulent and generous.



- Area: 4 hectares, 39 ares, and 73 centiares
- Locality: Solutré-Pouilly
- Soil: Brown limestone slope soils, very rocky, deep, and healthy.
- Altitude: 290 to 330 meters
- Exposure: South/ Southeast/ East orientation
- Slope: 15% grade.
