



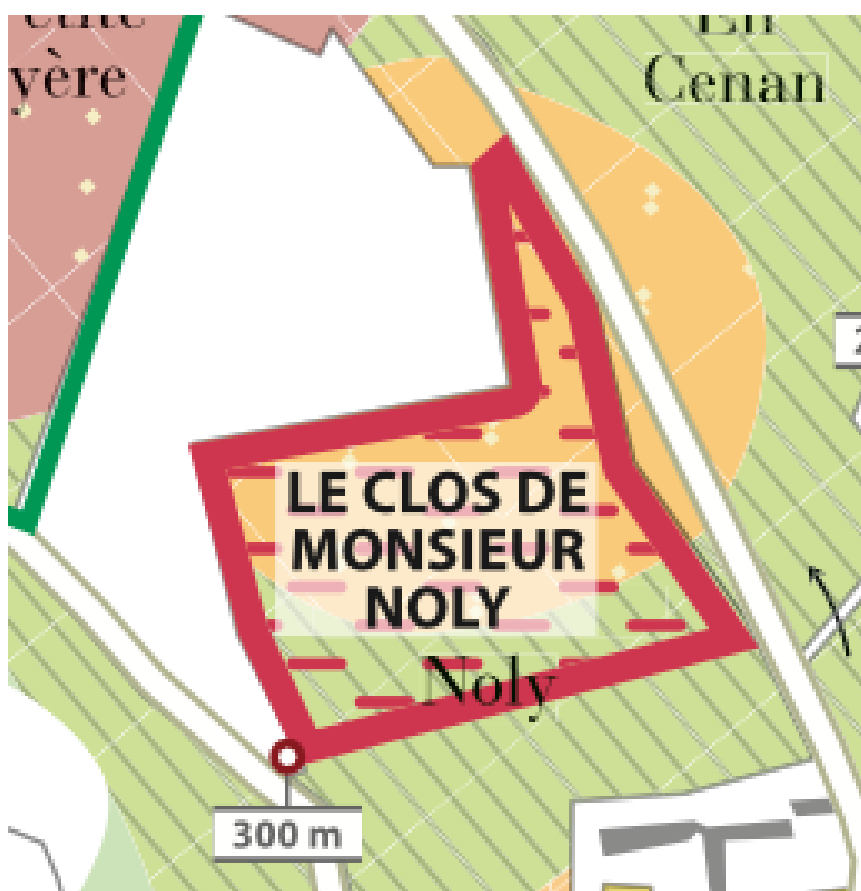
### 1ER CRU «LE CLOS MONSIEUR NOLY»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Partially classified.

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: This Clos, delimited by magnificent dry stone walls, belonged to a certain Mr. Noly. Only three vineyards are present in this Premier Cru.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: The smallest 1er Cru in Chaintré.

Organoleptic profile: Warm and early-maturing.



- Area: 2 hectares and 74 ares
- Locality: Chaintré
- Soil: Shallow brown soils derived from hard limestone with chailles.
- Altitude: 240 to 300 meters
- Exposure: East/Southwest orientation
- Slope: 5 to 10% grade.
