


Locality (on this 1er Cru): Partially classified

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: Partly classified at the top of the slope, Le Clos belonged to Mr. Reyssier.

<u>Special feature of this 1er Cru</u>: It is already found in sales registers and cadastral records dating back to 1942, historically the most recognized climate in the town of Chaintré. Historically defined by a wall in its entirety. Only the northern part remains today.

Organoleptic profile: Density, richness. The vines in this area are in a situation of early maturity.



• Area: 8 hectares and 68 ares

• Locality: Chaintré

 <u>Soil</u>: Brown residual clay soils on slopes resting on limestone with entroques, thickening at the bottom of the hill.

• Altitude: 220-265 meters

• Exposure: East orientation

• Slope: 10 to 15% grade.
