

1ER CRU «LES CHEVRIÈRES»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Les Chevrières, Les Robées, Aux Murs

<u>Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping</u>: This name is likely due to the fact that these lands were former wastelands where the only viable livestock farming was the raising of goats.

<u>Special feature of this 1er Cru</u>: It is extensive and located around the quarry of Chaintré. Many houses in Chaintré were built using stones from this quarry.

<u>Organoleptic profile</u>: Delicate, aromatic persistence, its orientation gives it a relative earliness. Elegance, finesse.



- Area: 11 hectares and 36 ares
- Locality: Chaintré
- <u>Soil</u>: Reddish brown slope soils derived from limestone with polypiers or entroques on marls or limestone rocky beds at a depth of 70-100 cm.
- Altitude: 250 to 300 meters
- <u>Exposure</u>: East/ Southeast/ Southwest orientation
- <u>Slope</u>: 3 to 15% grade.
