

1ER CRU «LES CHEVRIÈRES»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Les Chevrières, Les Robées, Aux Murs

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: This name is likely due to the fact that these lands were former wastelands where the only viable livestock farming was the raising of goats.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: It is extensive and located around the quarry of Chaintré. Many houses in Chaintré were built using stones from this quarry.

Organoleptic profile: Delicate, aromatic persistence, its orientation gives it a relative earliness. Elegance, finesse.



- Area: 11 hectares and 36 ares
- Locality: Chaintré
- Soil: Reddish brown slope soils derived from limestone with polypiers or entroques on marls or limestone rocky beds at a depth of 70-100 cm.
- Altitude: 250 to 300 meters
- Exposure: East/ Southeast/ Southwest orientation
- Slope: 3 to 15% grade.
