



1ER CRU «LES REISSES»

Locality (on this 1er Cru): Vers Pouilly

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: At the northern border between the town of Fuissé and the Hamlet of Pouilly, this 1er Cru was originally named "Vers Pouilly," but another common name, "Les Reisses," was preferred to avoid confusion with the Premier Cru "Pouilly" within the eponymous village.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: The first two houses of Pouilly are located in the town of Fuissé. This climat is an enclave of the town of Fuissé within the hamlet of Pouilly.

Organoleptic profile: Density and straightness.



- Area: 4 hectares, 12 ares, and 95 centiares
- Locality: Fuissé
- Soil: Brown residual clay soils, not very thick, non-calcareous, locally containing chailles, very calcareous at depth, as well as calcareous soils derived from Dogger marls, and brown-yellow stony soils with chailles.
- Altitude: 265 to 300 meters
- Exposure: East/Northeast orientation, with a portion of the 1st Cru facing the hamlet of Pouilly.
- Slope: On the reverse side of the hill.
