



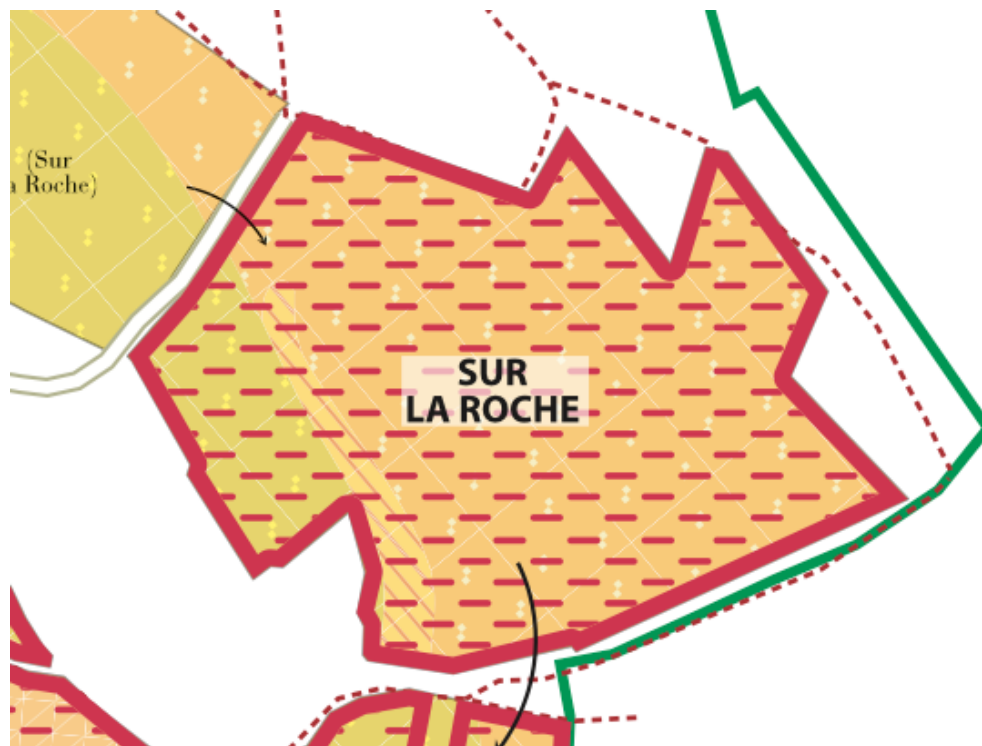
1ER CRU «SUR LA ROCHE»

Locality (under 1er Cru banner): Sur La Roche, La Maréchaude

Origin of the name of the climat and place-names, explanation of the grouping: This Premier Cru, whose name takes after the place where this vineyard is located, derives its name from the topographical situation of the site: The vines are planted on the back of the Roche de Vergisson. A road separates the upper part from the lower part classified as 1er Cru.

Special feature of this 1er Cru: Before it became a vineyard, these were former pastures owned by the town of Vergisson that occupied this climate where the bedrock emerges. It is undoubtedly the Premier Cru most deeply connected to our landscapes.

Organoleptic profile: Tension, lemony notes, white limestone dust, becoming iodized with aging.



- Area: 14 hectares and 76 ares
- Locality: Vergisson
- Soil: Brown soils with chailles derived from hard limestone, not very deep to moderately deep, clayey and with low limestone content on the surface.
- Altitude: 300 to 390 meters
- Exposure: East/ Southeast/ South orientation
- Slope: 12 to 15% grade.
